Plumas Hospital District (PHD) Reorganization: Regional Annexation (Plumas LAFCo) File No 2018-0002 of the territory within the Indian Valley Healthcare District (IVHD) to the PHD and concurrent Dissolution of the IVHD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Plumas Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) will hold a public protest hearing on Thursday, **September 19, 2019**, to receive written protest against the reorganization including annexation of 316,424 acres more or less of the Indian Valley Healthcare District (IVHD) to the Plumas Hospital District (PHD) and dissolution of the IVHD.

Owners of property and voters residing within the annexation territory may now file written protests against the proposal.

Proceedings for this proposal were initiated by the IVHD on November 14th, 2018 and the PHD on November 27, 2018. The Plumas Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) approved the proposal on August 12, 2019, which will be effective upon recordation of the Certificate of Completion. The hearing will **BEGIN** at 8:00 a.m. on **Thursday**, **September 19**, 2019, at the Greenville Town Hall at 152 Green Meadows Ln, Greenville California. The hearing will **END** at 8:30 a.m. if no one appears to submit a written protest in person.

To be counted, protests must be in writing and signed. They must be submitted before close of the hearing, and they must be made by owners of land within the area and (<u>or</u>) by registered voters residing within the subject territory. A form is printed below for the convenience of anyone wishing to file a protest; it may be copied or filled in, detached, and returned to the LAFCo office.

Protests may be mailed to Plumas LAFCo, 5050 Laguna Blvd, #112-711 Elk Grove, CA 95758 or delivered to the LAFCo Executive Officer or his designee at the protest hearing. Each protest must clearly state whether it is made by a landowner or a registered voter or submitted for both and must include the name and address of the person submitting it and original signature. Landowner protests must also include a street address or parcel number identifying the location of the property in question. A registered voter's protest must show the voter's name and residence address as it appears on the affidavit of registration.

The value of protests received and not withdrawn before the hearing concludes will be determined within 30 days following the hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 57075. For more information, please call the LAFCo office at (888) 501-0395.
